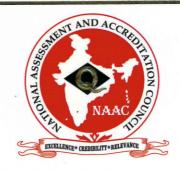

Infrastructure

Sterling Institute has excellent infrastructure to support all students to shape their career. Library

PLACEMENT GUIDELINES



- Students are encouraged to actively check their registered email accounts to stay informed about campus recruitment drives, including important details like eligibility criteria, dates, and venues. Staying updated ensures you make the most of every opportunity.
- > To make the most of placement opportunities, all eligible students are encouraged to actively participate in every recruitment drive until they secure a job.
- Students are free to make an informed decision after attending the company's Pre-Placement Talk (PPT). No student will be allowed to back out from the company after clearing the 1st round, and also after getting selected.
- > Students should review eligibility criteria shared in placement emails to ensure they meet company requirements. As academic records are verified at the time of joining, any discrepancies may affect the job offer and reputation.
- To ensure smooth coordination, students should keep their personal and academic data with the Placement Office accurate and updated. Any changes should be communicated promptly to the Placement Officer.

- Timely reporting for all placement activities, as per the schedule shared via email, reflects professionalism and commitment.
- > Students are expected to wear business formals for all recruitment activities, reflecting professionalism and workplace readiness.
- All placement-related queries must be directed to the Placement Officer to ensure clear and timely communication.
- The institute follows a 'One Student, One Job' policy, encouraging equal opportunities for all students. Once a student secures a placement, they will step aside from further recruitment drives, allowing their peers to benefit from the available opportunities. Recruitment processes may continue into the late evening. Students must inform their parents and ensure proper transport arrangements accordingly.
